- May submit up to *three* projects for consideration.

 One will be funded. List projects in order of highest priority first.
- Grant application guidelines will be sent if interested.
- Response within 6 months.
- Meet 4/year to consider grant awards.
- Deadline Rolling
- Notified in writing if not interested.
- Grant Inquiry Form
- Links to FAQ
- Apply: 1/year
- May award two or three years' support for a project, or make multi-year payments on awards. Generally, however, grants are awarded for one year at a time.

Average grant range: \$10,000 to \$200,000

Example grants – focus area: workforce development

- \$40,000 to Professional Career Development Services in Richardson,TX. for Assistance
 with staffing programs that return workers to the workforce by making them more hirable
 through education, grooming and skill development.
- \$200,000 to Valley Initiative For Development And Advancement in Mercedes,TX. for assistance with Workforce Development & Training for Low-Income Lower Rio Grande Valley Residents.
- \$35,000 to Juliette Fowler Communities in Dallas for Assistance toward the Workforce Readiness Program for young women who have aged out of foster care.
